Last admission to the museum is 45 minutes before closing.

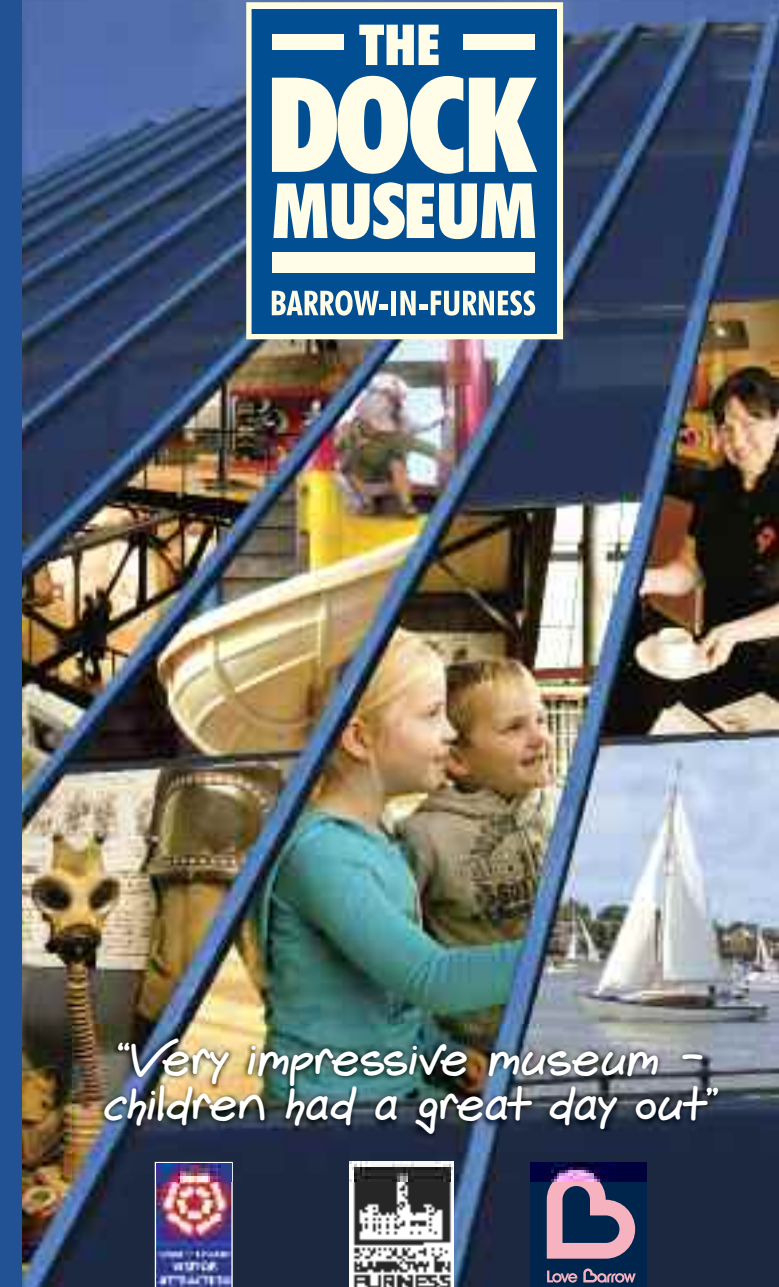

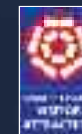
